In class role play activities and testing of key vocabulary and natural phrases learn through mini quizzes which will account for 30% of the grade. Monitored in class throughout the semester.

Usual Performance score: Participation in class weekly, motivation to learn, attitude in class, preparation and review-complete homework before class
